EVENT #01101 IN SUMMARY: R/O'S RESPONED TO A CALL OF A SUSPICIOUS PERSON AT ABOVE LOCATION. UPON ARRIVAL R/O'S MET WITH [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE) WHO WAS IN TEARS AND POINTED OUT KURTIS GARRETT (VICTIM) AS THE SUSPICIOUS PERSON THAT WAS FOLLOWING HER. [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE) STATED THAT SHE WAS ON HER WAY HOME AND WAS WALKING TOWARDS THE CTA TRAIN STATION LOCATED ON 69TH AND THE DAN RYAN. [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE) FURTHER RELATED THAT SHE WAS WALKING ON VINCENNES AVE TOWARDS 71ST ST FROM 72ND ST WHEN SHE OBSERVED KURTIS GARRETT (VICTIM) FOLLOWING HER AND STATING THAT THERE WAS NO ONE ELSE OUT BUT HIM AND HER. [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE) STATED THAT SHE WAS FRIGHTENED BY KURTIS GARRETT (VICTIM) ACTIONS / COMMENTS AND SHE RAN TO THE CITCO GAS STATION LOCATED AT 71ST / VINCENNES AND CALLED THE POLICE. R/O'S APPROACHED KURTIS GARRETT (VICTIM) FOR A FIELD INTERVIEW AND OBSERVED KURTIS GARRETT (VICTIM) PRETENDING TO TALK TO SOMEONE ON HIS CELL PHONE AND HE ALSO HAD A BICYCLE INNER TUBE IN HIS HAND. R/O'S ASKED VICTIM WHAT HE WAS DOING IN THE AREA AND VICTIM LOOKED NERVOUS AND INCOHERANT. R/O'S ASKED VICTIM HIS NAME, BIRTHDATE, AND WHERE HE RESIDED. R/O'S PLACED VICTIM IN HANDCUFFS FOR OFFICER SAFTEY AND NAME CHECKED HIM THROUGH LEADS WHICH CAME BACK CLEAR. [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE) STATED TO OFFICER IF SHE COULD GO HOME AND SHE WALKED TOWARDS THE CTA TRAIN STATION. R/O'S OFFERED VICTIM A RIDE HOME TO 6211 S ADA ST BUT THE VICTIM WAS DEMANDING TO BE UNCUFFED AND WAS ADDEMENT ABOUT WALKIN TOWARDS THE SAME TRAIN TRAIN STATION AS [REDACTED] (PERSON REPORTING OFFENSE). R/O'S TOLD THE VICTIM HE HAD 2 CHOICES TO EITHER GET A RIDE HOME FROM THEM OR HE WAS GOING TO BE TAKEN TO THE HOSPITAL FOR A MENTAL EVALUTION BECAUSE HE WAS BEING INCOHERANT AND NOT MAKING ANY SENSE. R/O'S ATTEMPTED TO PUT VICTIM INTO THEIR SQUAD CAR TO TAKE HIM HOME WITH NEG RESULTS. R/O'S REQUESTED A SQUADROL 772R AND THE VICTIM BEGAN TO YELL AND SCREAM THAT THE POLICE WERE TRYING TO MURDER HIM. 772R AND 726R ARRIVED ON SCENE AND ATTEMPTED TO ASSIST R/O'S IN TRANSPORTING VICTIM TO ST. BERNARD HOSPITAL FOR A MENTAL EVALUTION. R/O'S AND ASSISTING UNITS ATTEMPTED TO PLACE THE VICTIM IN THE SIDE COMPARMENT OF THE SQUADROL AND THE VICTIM RESISTED AND WOULDN'T LET THE R/O'S CLOSE THE COMPARMENT DOOR BY USING HIS FEET. R/O'S DECIDED TO PLACE VICTIM IN THE REAR COMPARMENT BECAUSE IT WAS LARGER AND THE VICTIM IS 6 FT 240 LBS. IN THE PROCESS OF TRANSFERRING THE VICTIM TO THE REAR COMPARMENT THE VICTIM ACCIDENTALLY HIT HS FACE ON THE REAR COMPARMENT DOOR CAUSING SEVERAL INJURIES LISTED ABOVE. 772R TRANSPORTED VICTIM TO ST. BERNARD HOSPITAL FOR A MENTAL EVALUTION AND TO BE TREATED FOR HIS INJURIES. VICTIM WAS TREATED BY DR. MURPHY FOR HIS INJURIES AND IS IN GOOD CONDITION AWATING A MENTAL EVALUTION.
