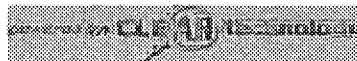

INVESTIGATION:

R/Ds were assigned to investigate a police related shooting which occurred at 2659 S. Avers. R/Ds proceeded immediately to that location. R/Ds were met by 10th District personnel who had secured the scene from 27th and Ridgeway to 27th and Harding, as well as Avers Avenue for 1/2 block north and south of 27th Street.

R/Ds learned that officers responding to a call of man with a gun had fired upon an armed offender who pointed a weapon at them. The offender, Juan PEREA, was wounded and had been transported to Mt. Sinai Hospital by CFD Ambulance prior to the R/Ds arrival. [Redacted] The offender's weapon was recovered at the scene.

The area of 27th and Avers is primarily residential, consisting of single family homes and two-flat apartment buildings. Avers runs one way going north and 27th Street is one way going east. The area is known to suffer from violent gang activity.

The crime scene consisted of seven expended shell casings immediately to the east of the building at 2659 S. Avers and a single live bullet at the curb on the northeast corner of 27th and Avers. Additionally, there were bloodstains and clothing (belonging to the offender PEREA) at the mouth of the gangway at 2651 S. Avers. A loaded 9mm semi-auto pistol was observed in the lawn at 2651 S. Avers. This was known to be the offender's weapon. A metal fragment was observed on the steps at 2655 S. Avers. R/Ds observed fresh damage to the paint of a wrought iron fence at this location.

R/Ds canvassed the area for witnesses and learned that two of the residents at 2652 S. Hamlin had information relevant to the case.

R/Ds interviewed the officers involved in the incident.

P.O. Drozdel related in summary and not verbatim that he and his partner P.O. Bautista responded to a call of a man with a gun at 2652 S. Hamlin. The officers arrived simultaneously with Officers Davis and Carrera. All of the officers were in full uniform, driving marked squad cars. The officers met [Redacted] who informed them that they had observed two M/WH/20s in the rear and side yards [Redacted] They observed these persons loading a semi-auto pistol and heard them arguing about it. The offenders walked west through the gangway just a minute before the officers arrived.

Officers Drozdel and Davis walked south in the west alley of Hamlin to 27th Street. Officers Bautista and Carrera continued west through the yards and gangways towards Avers, one block west of Hamlin.

Officer Drozdel stated that he emerged from the alley at 27th Street and walked west alongside the wall of the house. P.O. Davis was walking parallel to him, but in the street.

Officer Drozdel said he observed a M/WH standing near the manhole cover in the street at the northeast curb of 27th and Avers. This person, now known to be Francisco GONZALEZ, was yelling gang slogans at a vehicle facing east on 27th Street which had stopped at the stop sign at Avers.

The officers challenged GONZALEZ and ordered him to turn around. As Drozdel approached, he walked past the edge of the building into the open sidewalk. Davis was directing the offender to drop a radio and phone he was holding. As Drozdel approached, he glanced to the right and saw the offender PEREA advancing upon him from the gangway at 2659 S. Avers. PEREA was armed with a silver and black semi-auto pistol which he was pointing towards the officers. Drozdel announced his office and ordered PEREA to drop the gun. Instead, PEREA advanced and leveled the gun at the officers. Drozdel stated that in fear of his own and officer Davis' safety, he began firing his service weapon at PEREA, firing seven times. Perea fled northbound, but stumbled and fell at 2651 S. Avers, yelling that he had been shot. Drozdel notified OEMC that he had fired his weapon and requested an ambulance for the offender, who was immediately taken into custody.

P.O. Davis stated that when he saw Gonzalez flashing gang signs he ordered him to cease and also ordered him to drop the police scanner he was holding. Davis saw Drozdel out of the corner of his eye. He saw PEREA advancing upon them with a gun in his

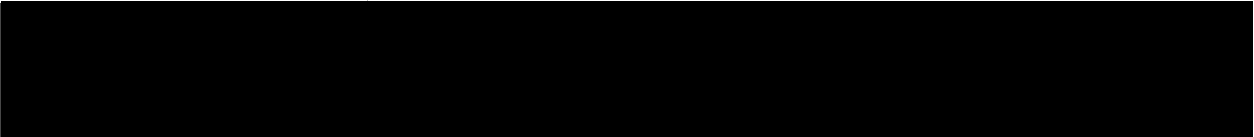

right hand pointing in their direction. Davis heard Drozdel yelling for PEREA to drop the gun and saw Drozdel fire at PEREA, who then fled northbound but fell down. Davis took GONZALEZ into custody, and secured the scene.

Officers Bautista and Carrera related that they heard loud voices on Avers as they walked through the rear yards from Hamlin to Avers. They heard Drozdel yelling "Police" and then heard shots. They ran through the gangway and when they emerged at 2651 Avers, they saw the offender PEREA run past them and stumble. Officer Bautista saw PEREA throw the gun he was holding away from himself as he fell. He immediately took PEREA into custody. The officers located and protected PEREA's weapon.

Various command and IPRA personnel came to the scene as it was being processed. Two evidence technicians were present to take photographs and to collect and inventory the physical evidence.



The offender GONZALEZ was transported to Area Central where he was informed of his Constitutional rights. A GSR was conducted and his clothing was inventoried.

Upon being interviewed, GONZALEZ cooperated with the investigation and stated that he was with PEREA. He stated that PEREA compelled him to stand watch and to try to provoke rival gangs by flashing gang signs. GONZALEZ had a police scanner. GONZALEZ saw the police approach, heard them yell for PEREA to drop the gun and saw PEREA disobey the police and point a gun at them when police fired. GONZALEZ led officers to a garage at 26th and Ridgeway where a 45 caliber semi-auto pistol was discovered.

He was interviewed by A.S.A. Tomasek after which he was released without charging for lack of evidence against him.

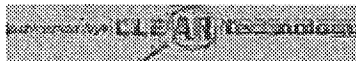
The offender PEREA was treated and released at Mt. Sinai Hospital for gunshot wounds to the right chest and right thigh. He was advised of his Constitutional rights and denied the allegations. He gave several conflicting accounts of his activities prior to the shooting and denied having a gun or pointing one at the officers. Upon being taken to Area Central, he again denied involvement and requested an attorney.

A.S.A. Tomasek interviewed all parties in this investigation, and after reviewing the reports and taking statements from [redacted] and GONZALEZ, she approved felony charges against PEREA. He was charged with two counts of aggravated assault to a P.O.; one count of UUW by felon and one count of armed habitual criminal. He is slated to appear in Branch 44 on 25 July.

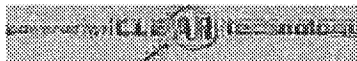
