

INVESTIGATION:

R/D's investigation revealed through witness and Officer accounts the following information. Officers Bruno and Streeper, BT, 368C, were on patrol in the area of 71st and Paxton traveling W/B when they heard loud reports in their immediate vicinity. The officers, who were in full uniform in a marked police vehicle, made a u-turn on 71st Street and went E/B to Paxton. The Officers then heard at least 5 more gun shots and observed muzzle flashes and commotion at a silver mini-van stopped in the 7000 block of Paxton. The victim The mini-van then fled from was shot in his left shoulder at the location of the grea S/B on Paxton directly in front of 368C's vehicle. Officers Bruno and Streeper gave chase to the Silver Mini-Van with lights and sirens activated. The Dodge mini-van fled S/B on Paxton, W/B on 73rd Street, and S/B in the west alley of Paxton. Officers noticed that the passenger side sliding door was open approximately halfway down the alley. When the mini-van reached 7357 S. Merrill, a male exited the mini van from the sliding door holding a handgun in his right hand. As the offender, now known as Jeffery KEMP, fled W/B on the north sidewalk, PO's Bruno and Streeper continued to follow the mini-van that had turned W/B on 74th Street and KEMP. PO Bruno gave KEMP verbal directions to stop, police, drop the gun. KEMP turned toward Bruno and Streeper and raised the weapon at the officers. Bruno fired two rounds at KEMP from a seated position in the passenger side of the police vehicle, striking KEMP in the chin and in the right side of the back, which was lodged. KEMP fell into the grass at 2138 E. 74th Street. Bruno and Streeper continued to follow the Mini Van until the Officers reached Merrill Street. PO Bruno got out of the Police vehicle and went back to apprehend KEMP. Bruno observed that KEMP was now laying in the street. Streeper followed the van to Jeffery Ave and turned around to assist PO Bruno. KEMP was placed into handcuffs by beat 4112D, who responded to assist BT. 368C. Officers observed and secured the weapon that KEMP pointed at Bruno and Streeper which was now located on the sidewalk at 2138 E 74th Street. Victim was transported to Jackson Park Hospital via CFD Ambulance #55. was treated and released by Dr. . KEMP succumbed to his wounds and was pronounced on scene by ME

Investigator Briggs #76 at 0140 hrs.

R/D's canvassed the area in an attempt to locate witnesses. See witness section for results of the canvass, R/D's also attempted to locate private video and PODS in the area with negative results.
