INVESTIGATION:

This report should be read in conjunction to all reports listed under this Records Division Number. The R/Ds were assigned to the listed Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer by Sgt. Pierce #1135 of this command. Sgt. Pierce related that an individual now known as NEALON Rayshawn had been placed into custody by Beat 495 for Obstruction and Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer. Sgt. Pierce stated that Beat 495 had stopped another individual now known as [REDACTED] for a traffic violation. During this stop NEALON had interfered, refusing to leave the scene when ordered by the officer. Sgt. Pierce stated that Beat 495 attempted to place NEALON into custody at which time a struggle ensued as NEALON resisted arrest. Sgt. Pierce stated that NEALON had been transported to South Shore Hospital for a laceration to the back of his head and that the involved officers were in the 004th District awaiting the arrival of the R/Ds. The R/Ds relocated to the 004th District where the investigation would begin.

Upon arriving in the 004th District the R/Ds spoke with Beat 495 Officer L. Del Coiro #11738. The officer related the following in essence but not verbatim.

DEL CORIO #11738:

The officer related essentially the same facts as stated in the Original Incident Case Report. The officer stated that he was on duty, in full uniform, working ninety-nine (alone). The officer stated that he stopped [REDACTED] for a traffic violation at approximately 8755 S. Exchange. The officer related he issued [REDACTED] several citations and informed her that her vehicle was being impounded for no driver's license and no insurance.

The officer stated that a US Postal worker now known as NEALON then approached on foot, in the street, offering his phone to [REDACTED]. The officer stated that he ordered NEALON several times to back away and to remove himself from the street. The officer stated that NEALON became verbally abusive and threw his phone in the direction of the officer and [REDACTED]. The officer stated that the cell phone hit the ground and slid under [REDACTED] vehicle. The officer stated that NEALON then became visibly upset that his cell phone hit the ground and demanded that the officer retrieve it. The officer stated that he again ordered NEALON to back away and to wait until his traffic stop with [REDACTED] was completed. NEALON then replied " Fuck you she needs my phone!"

The officer stated that he then called for an assist as an unruly crowd began to gather. The officer stated that he then observed NEALON approach [REDACTED] vehicle and attempt to give his phone to [REDACTED]. The officer stated that he then approached NEALON and attempted to place him into custody at which time NEALON pushed the officer back. The officer stated that a struggle ensued and that NEALON then grabbed the officer attempting to throw him to the ground. The officer stated that he was holding his police radio in his hand and in an attempt to ward off the assailant the officer struck NEALON on the back of the head with said radio. The officer stated that assist units arrived and that NEALON was placed into custody. The officer stated that NEALON was then transported to South Shore Hospital by Beat 455 where he was treated and released for a laceration to the back of the head. The officer had nothing further to add.

HILL, Keith #11566

The R/Ds then spoke with Beat 494 P/O K. HILL #11566. The officer related the following in essence but not verbatim. The officer stated that he responded to Beat 495's call for an assist. The officer stated that he too was working ninety-nine (alone) and upon arriving on the scene observed NEALON under [REDACTED] vehicle retrieving an unknown item. HILL stated that NEALON began to walk away when approached by DEL CORIO. HILL stated that he then observed NEALON push DEL CORIO and stated "get the fuck off me". HILL stated that a struggle ensued at which time DEL CORIO struck NEALON with his hand held radio. HILL stated that NEALON was placed into custody and then transported to South Shore Hospital. HILL had nothing further to add.

[REDACTED] (Security Guard for "Special Patrol")

The R/Ds then spoke with Security Guard [REDACTED] related the following in essence but not verbatim. [REDACTED] related that he was working as an on duty security guard for "Special Patrol". [REDACTED] stated that he monitored a radio call of "Assist the police" in the area of 88th & Exchange. [REDACTED] stated that he wasn't far from the area. [REDACTED] stated that when he arrived at 88th & Exchange, he observed a male black subject lying on the ground. [REDACTED] stated that it appeared to him that the same subject was attempting to retrieve something from underneath a vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that there was a Chicago Police Officer (Del Coiro) standing on the opposite side of the vehicle. [REDACTED] stated the male black subject (Now known as NEALON) now stood up and began to argue with that same officer. [REDACTED] stated the officer told NEALON to leave the area. [REDACTED] stated that NEALON now began to walk away, but turned back around and approached the officer. [REDACTED] stated that the officer raised his hand and once again instructed NEALON to leave the area. [REDACTED] stated he then observed NEALON fighting with the officer. [REDACTED] had nothing further to add.

NARRATIVES



The Reporting Detectives spoke with NEALON in the processing area of the 004th District. Detective Meister #20423, in the presence of Detective Granat #20291 read and advised NEALON of his rights at 2024 hrs. NEALON stated that he understood his rights and wished to speak to the Reporting Detectives in regards to this incident. NEALON related the following in essence but not verbatim.

NEALON, Rayshawn:

NEALON related that he was delivering mail in the area of 88th & Exchange. NEALON stated he was standing outside of his postal vehicle. NEALON stated that he observed a Chicago Police Officer talking to a woman (now known as [REDACTED] who was seated in a car. NEALON stated that during the conversation between the police officer and the woman, he heard the woman state that her phone was dead. NEALON stated that he now walked towards the police officer and the woman. NEALON stated that he then asked the police officer if he could give the woman his cell phone to use. NEALON stated the officer told him, not now you have to step away. NEALON stated that the woman asked him directly if she could use his phone. NEALON stated that he once again asked the officer if he could give the woman his cell phone. NEALON stated that the officer again told him no and to step away. NEALON stated he then tossed his cell phone towards the woman and police officer but missed his target. NEALON stated that his cell phone hit the ground and went under the woman's car. NEALON stated that he then asked the officer if he could get his cell phone. NEALON stated the officer told him, not right now.

NEALON stated that he then walked back to his work vehicle, entered and drove the vehicle to a parking spot directly across from the woman's car. NEALON stated that he saw several neighborhood people starting to gather and yell at the police officer. NEALON stated that he heard the police officer calling for back-up. NEALON stated that he waited, and then exited his vehicle. NEALON stated that he walked toward the woman's car. NEALON stated to R/D's that in retrospect he knew that was a bad idea to exit his vehicle and walk over. NEALON stated that he once again asked the officer if he could retrieve his cell phone. NEALON stated that the officer replied, I don't care / fuck it. NEALON stated that he was unsure if the police officer was speaking to him or someone else. NEALON stated that he then approached the woman's car and retrieved his cell phone.

NEALON stated that after he retrieved his cell phone, he stood up and began to walk away. NEALON stated that the police officer now approached him and grabbed his shirt near his chest area. NEALON stated that he didn't remember if he pushed the officer or not. NEALON stated that he brushed away the police officers hand. NEALON stated that the officer stated to him, now you're under arrest. NEALON stated that he then fought with the officer and continued to state that he was not going to be arrested and defended himself. NEALON stated to R/D's that he has wrestled in the past and knew if he got the officer to the ground "it would be over". NEALON stated that he does not carry any weapons like the police officer does and that isn't fair. NEALON stated that during the fight, the officer struck him in his head with a police radio. NEALON stated that he was angry and does not like being touched. NEALON stated that two officers tried to get his hands around his back. NEALON stated that it all happened so fast and couldn't remember everything. NEALON had nothing further to add.

R/Ds relocated back to 8755 s. Exchange, noted and canvassed the area with negative results. It should be noted that a Catholic Grammar school / Immaculate Conception, is located directly where the incident occurred. ET arrived and photographed both the Officer and NEALON.

R/Ds then relocated to 1518 E. 72nd st. in an attempt to interview [REDACTED]. Upon arriving, R/Ds spoke with [REDACTED] who related that [REDACTED] doesn't reside there but the residents who reside in the basement might know of her. R/Ds could hear [REDACTED] speaking with an unknown individual at the basement door. [REDACTED] then related that the occupant in the basement refused to speak with R/Ds and closed the front door.

It should be noted that attorney CECE, Frank jr. arrived at the 004th District, representing NEALON and at 2230 hrs revoked his right to remain silent and refused to answer any further questions

R/Ds then contacted felony review and presented the facts of the case to Cook County ASA Kye. ASA Kye reviewed the facts and at 2305 hours approved the charge of Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer. This case is CLEARED CLOSED BY ARREST AND PROSECUTION.
