RE: Non-Concurrence with IPRA sustained allegations, Log No. 1066371

Dear Superintendent Johnson:

Pursuant to Municipal Code of Chicago Section 2-57-060 and Police Board Rules of Procedures Section VI, your letter dated march 27, 2017 does not require review by a three-member panel of the Police Board because we are in agreement as to the recommended discipline for the accused officers. I have made this determination in consultation with the Department of Law.

I have reviewed your response; however I respectfully maintain my support for the allegations, findings and recommendations made in IPRA's summary report. Notably you concur with multiple Rule 14 allegations against Officer Fry and Officer Lobianco. It is precisely because of their damaged credibility that the remaining allegations against them are sustained and should remain sustained.

Please refer this case to the Department of Law to draft charges seeking the separation of Officer Fry and Officer Lobianco from the Chicago Police Department.
