(EVENT #10897) IN SUMMARY, AO'S RESPONDED TO A MAN WITH A GUN CALL AT 50TH AND WABASH. DISPATCH RELATED THAT AN OFF DUTY CHICAGO POLICE SGT. PENDARVIS #1937 (WITNESS) ON-VIEWED A MAROON/RED CHEVY MISSING A BUMPER OCCUPIED AT LEAST TWICE WITH MALE BLACKS WITH DREADS DRIVING IN TRAFFIC

R/O'S BEGAN TO TOUR THE AREA OF THE LAST KNOWN LOCATION OF VEHICLE (50TH AND WABASH). WHILE R/OS TOURED AREA, AT APPROXIMATELY 43RD AND STATE, AO'S OBSERVED VEHICLE THAT MATCHED THE DESCRIPTION GIVEN FROM FLASH MESSAGE. AO'S PULLED BEHIND A MAROON CHEVROLET EQUINOX MISSING A BUMPER OCCUPIED AT LEAST TWICE WITH A MALE PASSENGER WHO HAD DREADS AT THE BP GAS STATION AT 43RD AND STATE. SAID VEHICLE THEN ACCELERATED AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED GOING NORTHBOUND ON STATE ST AND A BRIEF PURSUIT ENSUED AND EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT WAS ACTIVATED. AT APPROXIMATELY 20 E, 42ND ST, THE OFFENDERS VEHICLE STRUCK A BLACK INFINITI (REPORT FOR ACCIDENT UNDER HZ317472. R/O'S IMMEDIATLEY WERE ON SCENE WITH BEAT 225 AND CALLED DISPATCH FOR MULTIPLE AMBULENCES. VICTIMS OF BLACK INFINITI WERE (MOTHER) AND (SON). BOTH OF THOSE VICTIMS WERE TAKEN TO STROGER WITH MINOR INJURIES, TREATED BY ATTENDING PHYSICIAN DR. KAMINSKY AND LISTED IN

GOOD CONDITION. THERE WERE THREE OFFENDERS INSIDE MAROON CHEVROLET EQUINOX WITH PLATES THAT FLED FROM R/O'S. A LEADS INQUIRY REVEALED THAT CAR WAS STOLEN UNDER RD # HZ315230.
