NARRATIVE

EVENT #19125. WHILE ON ROUTINE PATROL, R/S OBSERVED A BLUE 1980 PONTIAC FIREBIRD/TRANS AM PULL UP TO THE CURB AT 1030 N RUSH. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER), WHO WAS SEATED IN THE DRIVER'S SEAT, WITH THE ENGINE ON AND THE KEY IN THE IGNITION, WAS THEN OBSERVED DRINKING FROM A 40OZ BOTTLE OF BUDWEISER BEER. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) EXITED THE VEHICLE AT WHICH TIME R/S APPROACHED MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) FOR A FIELD INTERVIEW AND IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A CHICAGO POLICE SERGEANT. R/S ORDERED THE SUBJECT TO PRODUCE A DRIVERS LICENSE AND PROOF OF INSURANCE, BUT MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) REFUSED TO COMPLY AND ATTEMPTED TO WALK AWAY. ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER), WHO WAS SEATED IN THE RIGHT FRONT PASSENGER SEAT OF THE VEHICLE, EXITED THE VEHICLE AND REMOVED A WHITE PLASTIC BAG FROM THE INTERIOR OF THE VEHICLE, BEFORE PLACING THE SAME BEHIND A CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION BARRIER AT 1110 N STATE ST. BEAT 1884A RECOVERED THE ITEM AND DISCOVERED IT TO CONTAIN A PARTIALLY CONSUMED 40 OZ BOTTLE OF BUDWEISER BEER. ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY FOR OBSTRUCTION AFTER ATTEMPTING TO REMOVE AND CONCEAL THE ITEM FROM THE VEHICLE. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS TOLD HE WAS BEING PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR DUI AND STATED "FUCK YOU, COME HERE!" MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) THEN BLADED HIS BODY IN A FIGHTING STANCE AND BALLED UP HIS FISTS IN A THREATENING MANNER, PLACING BEAT 1884 IN REASONABLE APPREHENSION OF RECEIVING A BATTERY. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS APPROACHED WITH ASSISTING UNITS TO AFFECT THE ARREST, AT WHICH TIME MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) LOCKED HIS ARMS TOGETHER IN FRONT OF HIS BODY, STIFFENED HIS BODY, AND THEN BEGAN TO PULL HIS ARMS AWAY. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS PLACED INTO CUSTODY AND CONTINUED RESISTING BY NOT WALKING TO VEHICLE AND REFUSED TO ENTER SAME. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS PARTIALLY INSIDE THE VEHICLE AND BEGAN FLAILING HIS BODY WHICH CAUSED HIM TO FALL BETWEEN THE SEAT AND THE DIVIDER CAUSING A MINOR INJURY TO HIS RIGHT EAR. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS EVENTUALLY TRANSPORTED INTO THE 018TH DISTRICT BY BEAT 1872R. A NAME CHECK WHILE IN THE 018TH DIST REVEALED THAT THE SUBJECT HAD A REVOKED DRIVERS LICENSE FOR A PREVIOUS DUI. UPON ARRIVAL IN THE STATION, MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) READ THE WARNING TO MOTORIST FROM A PREPRINTED FORMSET, BUT REFUSED TO SUBMIT TO SFST'S AND CHEMICAL TESTING. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS TAKEN TO ILLINOIS MASONIC FOR HIS INJURIES, WHERE HE BECAME BELIGERENT TO THE HOSPITAL STAFF AND REFUSED TO COOPERATE, CAUSING THE HOSPITAL TO REFUSE HIM TREATMENT. MAURICE HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO ST JOSEPHS HOSPITAL. WHEN ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS TRANSPORTED INTO THE 018TH STATION FOR PROCESSING, BEAT 1891 ATTEMPTED TO ENTER THE INTERVIEW ROOM WHERE ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) WAS SEATED TO CONDUCT A CUSTODIAL SEARCH. AS BEAT 1891 ENTERED THE ROOM, ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) KICKED AN OPEN DOOR CLOSED, CAUSING IT TO SLAM INTO BEAT 1891'S HAND. ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) THEN STRUCK BEAT 1891 ON THE HEAD WITH A CLOSED FIST, MAKING PHYSICAL CONTACT, AT WHICH TIME BEAT 1891, ACTING IN SELF DEFENSE, STRUCK ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) IN THE FACE WITH A CLOSED FIST TO CAUSE HIM TO CEASE HIS AGGRESSIVE ACTIONS AND OVERCOME HIS RESISTANCE TO CONTROL. ANTHONY HAWKS(OFFENDER) SUSTAINED A LACERATION TO HIS LOWER LIP AS A RESULT, AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO NORTHWESTERN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT TO SUCH. BEAT 1891 TREATED AND RELEASED FROM ST JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL FOR INJURY TO RIGHT HAND--CONTUSION, WHICH WAS ALSO REPORTED AS AN INJURY ON DUTY. PARTIALLY CONSUMED 40 OZ BEER BOTTLE INVENTORIED UNDER #13250753. IN CUSTODY: M/1/39 HAWKS, MAURICE CHARGES: PENDING COURT: PENDING IN CUSTODY: M/1/44 HAWKS, ANTHONY CHARGES: PENDING COURT: PENDING
