ALLEGATIONS

Sergeant A alleged that on 02 May 2017 at 1525 hours, inside the XXXth District Station at XXXX W. Ogden Ave., accused Officer A, was inattentive to duty in that she did not properly handle a Taser causing it to discharge, in violation of Rule 10.

SUMMARY

Investigation:

Sergeant A related that while Officer A was preparing for her tour of duty in the XXXth District Station locker room, she accidentally discharged the Taser while trying to holster the device. No injuries were reported. Officer A completed a TRR documenting the Taser discharge. In a To/From report dated 08 June 2017, Officer A acknowledged that she accidentally discharged her Taser as she tried to holster the device while standing in the XXXth District female locker room. Officer A completed her Taser requalification on 01 March 2017.

Conclusion:

The Reporting Investigator recommends a finding of Sustained for the allegations that Officer A was inattentive to duty in that she failed to properly handle a Taser causing it to discharge. Officer A was solely responsible for the proper handling of the Taser.

FINDINGS – RECOMMENDATIONS

Finding:

Allegation #1: Sustained – Violation of Rule 10, “Inattention to duty,” in that on 02 May 2017, at 1525 hours, at the location of 3315 W. Ogden Ave., Officer A was inattentive to duty in that she failed to properly handle a Taser causing it to discharge.
