Dear Ms. Nunez:

This is in response to your letter of May 23, 2018, requesting a 30-day extension of time for COPA to release records related to the above-referenced police-involved shooting. As set forth in your letter, I understand that this request is being made because ATF believes that the release of this material on or before July 3, 2018 (the 60-day mark since the event) would interfere with pending law enforcement proceedings, and would create a substantial likelihood that a person would be deprived of a fair trial or an impartial hearing, as contemplated in Section 7(1)(d) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d).

In response to your request for an extension, I am granting such an extension for 14-days, rather than the full period of 30-days you have requested. Based on this extension, COPA shall release these materials on July 17, 2018 pursuant to the terms of COPA's Records Release Policy.
