
Officer stated Ms. where to park her vehicle, but Ms. chose to park across the intersection. Officer stated, "Fine, I guess I'll give you a ticket for parking in a crosswalk." Officer positioned his vehicle on the other side of the intersection facing the rear of Ms. stated, "So vehicle on the other side of the intersection facing the rear of Ms. called her friend and told her she was being racially profiled. Approximately 20 minutes later, Ms. carrived at the scene. Officer was still parked across the intersection. Officer drove around the area momentarily and then drove away. Ms. left Mr. style-left where she parked it. Per Ms. officer never made any racial remarks or reference during their interaction. Ms. felt she was racially profiled because she did not believe that Officer would have physically threatened to arrest a white woman.
b. Digital Evidence
COPA reviewed the Body-Worn-Camera (BWC) footage from the incident, which captured the interaction between Ms. and Officer explained to Ms. why he stopped her and told her that he would give her a break and only issue one citation. Officer appeared to be patient with Ms. as she talked on her cellular telephone throughout the incident. Ms. related that she was driving someone else's vehicle and that she was not at fault for the vehicle not having valid insurance or a city sticker. Ms. became sarcastic toward Officer as he explained to her that the vehicle was required to have a city sticker. At that point, Officer stated, "Ok, I'm done being nice to you," and returned to his vehicle to write the citation.
Officer had Ms. sign the citation, returned her driver's license and told her to have a good day. Upon driving away, Officer instructed Ms. to move the vehicle out the crosswalk and to park legitimately. Ms. saked Officer for his Star number, to which he responded, "It's on the citation." Moments later, Officer approached Ms. who was still parked in the crosswalk. Officer exited his vehicle and gave Ms. verbal commands where to park the uninsured vehicle and that if she failed to do so she would be arrested. Ms. exchanged words with Officer and did not follow his verbal commands. Ms. stated she wanted to park elsewhere and drove the vehicle across the intersection and appeared to park in a crosswalk.
Officer returned to his vehicle and apparently parked on the other side of the intersection. No further interaction between Officer and Ms. was captured on BWC. ³
