Complainant alleged that Chicago Police Department ("CPD") members arrested her husband without justification. The evidence shows that a store employee called for CPD assistance and told officers on the scene that the Complainant's husband had splashed water in his face, after which the employee hit the Complainant's husband in self-defense. The store employee signed a complaint and the CPD members arrested the Complainant's husband. The officers are exonerated of the allegations of false arrest because the alleged victim's signed complaint gave the officers probable cause to arrest the Complainant's husband.


