Stated that Officer Johnson occeded to pull him towards the front of the yard by the links of the handcuffs and Officer elearz held on to shoulder. Shoulder added that as he was being lead out of the yard tripped over a tree stump and struck his head against a steel fence.

Officer Mielcarz denied observing Officer Johnson physically abuse Garfeed. Officer Mielcarz denied conducting a strip search of person. Officer Mielcarz denied observing Officer Johnson commit the aforementioned act.³

In a To/From Subject Report dated November 25, 2015, Accused Officer Charlie Johnson, #16589, described as very uncooperative during his arrest. Officer Johnson reported that was taken into custody after he was positively identified as the subject who delivered .4 grams of suspect heroin to Under Cover Officer Randolph. Officer Johnson handcuffed Garfeed and placed him in the rear passenger seat of the unmarked police vehicle without incident. In the process of escorting to the vehicle, began to swing his body from side to side in an apparent attempt to sling his body and head against everything, including but not limited to the front gate of the property. Officer Johnson reported that despite efforts to cause injury to himself, he was unsuccessful. Officer Johnson denied pulling and causing him to strike his head against an iron gate. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz commit the aforementioned act. Officer Johnson denied stating words to the effect of, "Shut the fuck up." Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz commit the aforementioned act. Officer Johnson denied striking Garfeed about his face, head and ears. Officer Johnson denied conducting a strip search of person. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz commit the aforementioned act.4

b. Documentary Evidence

The Original Incident Case Report, Vice Supplementary Report and Arrest Report for RD #HX515351 document that on November 21, 2014, at approximately 4:12 p.m. was arrested after was positively identified as the individual whodelivered a white powdered substance, which was believed to be heroin, to an undercover Chicago police officer, Officer Randolph, #9663, in exchange for money. According to the lockup screening log, and the arrest report, Mr. did not have obvious pain and/or injury.⁵

1. Officer Charlie Johnson, #16589

Allegations #1 - 4: Not Sustained

COPA recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #1 that Officer Johnson pulled and caused him to strike his head against an iron gate. stated that the arresting officers pulled him by the links of the handcuffs and his shoulder. added that as he was pulled by the arresting officers he tripped over a tree stump and struck his head against an iron gate. There are no medical reports to support allegations. Officers Johnson and Mielcarz reported that as they were escorting to the police vehicle a second time, Mr. attempted to swing his head and body in efforts to injure himself. Officers Johnson and Mielcarz reported that was unsuccessful in injuring himself. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz pulling causing to strike his head against an iron gate. Officer Mielcarz denied committing the act alleged against him. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.
COPA recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #2 that Officer Johnson stated words to the effect of, "Shut the fuck up." Officer Mielcarz denied hearing Officer Johnson make the statements as alleged against him. Officer Johnson denied observing any Department member commit the acts alleged by Officer Johnson denied making the statements as alleged against him. No independent evidence exists that supports or refutes the allegations. There is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegations.
COPA recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #3 that Officer Johnson conducted a strip search of his person. There were no witnesses regarding this allegation. Officer Mielcarz denied observing Officer Johnson commit the act alleged against him. Officer Johnson denied committing the act alleged against him. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.
COPA recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #4 that Officer Johnson struck about his face. There are no medical reports to support allegations. Additionally, booking photos from the time of arrest do not show any visible injuries to his face. Officer Mielcarz denied observing Officer Johnson commit the act alleged against him. Officer Johnson denied committing the act alleged against him. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.
2. Officer Jason Mielcarz Allegations #1 – 3: Not Sustained
COPA recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #1 , that Officer Mielcarz pulled and caused him to strike his head against an iron gate stated that the arresting officers pulled him by the links of the handcuffs and his shoulder. added that as he was pulled by the arresting officers he tripped over a tree stump and struck his head against an iron gate. There are no medical reports to support allegations. Officers Johnson and Mielcarz reported that as they were escorting to the police vehicle.

swing his head and body in efforts to injure himself. Officers Johnson and Mielcarz reported that Mr. was unsuccessful in injuring himself. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz pulling Mr. causing Mr. to strike his head against an iron gate. Officer Mielcarz denied committing the act alleged against him. No independent evidence exists that supports or refutes the allegations. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.

COPA recommends a finding of **Not Sustained** for **Allegation #2**, that Officer Mielcarz stated words to the effect of, "Shut the fuck up." stated that while inside the police vehicle he asked the officers why he was being arrested. stated that one of the arresting officers stated words to the effect of, "Shut the fuck up." There were no witnesses regarding this allegation. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz commit the act alleged against him. Officer Mielcarz denied committing the act alleged against him. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.

COPA recommends a finding of **Not Sustained** for **Allegation #3** that Officer Mielcarz conducted a strip search of person. Stated that Officer Mielcarz conducted a strip search of his person. There are no independent witnesses regarding this allegation. Officer Johnson denied observing Officer Mielcarz commit the act alleged against him. Officer Mielcarz denied committing the act alleged against him. Based on the available evidence, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation.

VII. CONCLUSION

Based on the analysis set forth above, COPA makes the following findings:
