



### **ANALYSIS**

COPA recommends a finding of UNFOUNDED for Allegation #1, that Officer Daniel
Sanchez mistreated in violation of Rule 9. The multiple body worn cameras
captured the incident. Although Mr. alleged that Officer Sanchez mistreated him, the
footage clearly established that Mr. was uncooperative and threatening towards Officer
Sanchez. Officer Sanchez did not respond unprofessionally to Mr. provocations.
Therefore, this allegation is Unfounded.
COPA recommends a finding of <b>UNFOUNDED</b> for <b>Allegation #2</b> that <b>Officer Danon Bright</b> physically maltreated causing bruising to his wrist and face in violation of Rule 8. The video footage from the body worn cameras shows the incident did not occur as alleged by Mr. As Mr. fled from officers, Officer Bright reached out to grab Mr. who then stumbled and fell face down on the pavement.
As officers attempted to place Mr. in custody, Mr. ignored the verbal command of officers and resisted arrest by thrashing his body. It took several officers to gain control of Mr. and place him in custody. Mr. continued resisting, thrashing and being uncooperative after he was handcuffed. His resistance required the officers to forcibly place him inside the police SUV. Mr. continued with his aggressive behavior throughout his transport and at the hospital, including him kicking the windows of the police SUV multiple times.
Based on the BWC footage of this incident, Mr. caused injury to himself as he fell while fleeing from officers, and then thrashed his body while being handcuffed. Therefore, this allegation is Unfounded.

### CONCLUSION

Based on the analysis set forth above, COPA makes the following findings:
