Officer Dixon pulled up behind the male driver, who was allegedly parked illegally, and started to
write a citation. The female driver was also alleged to be parked illegally. As Officer Dixon
handed a citation to the male driver, approached Officer Dixon and asked him why he
gave people tickets rather than asking them to move. Officer Dixon replied, "Well, I just hate for
people to do dumb nigger shit." Mr. told Officer Dixon that because he is a police officer,
he should not use that type of language. Officer Dixon replied that he never called the guy a racist
term, but only said that he hates when people do dumb nigger shit.

According to Mr. the male driver was present and heard the comment made by Officer Dixon, however, the female driver had already left. Mr. also said that he was familiar with Officer Dixon because he regularly wrote tickets near the bank, and that he had never heard Officer Dixon use such language before.

#### Officer Ricardo Dixon<sup>6</sup>

Officer Dixon appeared at COPA for a recorded interview on July 11, 2018. Officer Dixon said that he did not directly recall the incident, but that he regularly worked in the area of the incident. He also said that while he may have used the word "nigger" while on duty with other black officers, he did not believe that he ever used the word while dealing with a member of the public. Officer Dixon maintained that even when people complain and say derogatory things to him about what he is doing as an officer, such as writing tickets, he does not get impatient; he is strictly professional, he does not curse and he treats people the way he wants them to treat him.

Officer Dixon disclosed that he was familiar with the security guard at Bank of America named but said that he never discussed the incident with him.

#### b. Documentary Evidence

# Log #1078793, Face Sheet-Reporting Party:

This Face Sheet reported that the accused officer was rude, belligerent and used derogatory language toward him while he was being issued a citation. Mr. alleged that the accused officer said, "I don't give a fuck about this nigga shit, fuck you!"

## Log #1078793, Face Sheet-Reporting Party:

This Face Sheet reported that the accused officer gave traffic citations to unknown individuals and afterward remarked, "That's that Nigga Shit." Mr. further alleged that he questioned the officer about his remark and the officer stated, "I don't like that Nigga Shit."

#### VI. ANALYSIS

The Burden of Proof COPA must satisfy to support the findings for the allegations discussed below is preponderance of the evidence.

COPA recommends the finding for Allegation #1, that it is alleged that on January 8, 2016, at 6900 S. Ashland Ave., Officer Ricardo Dixon used derogatory language while speaking to Mr. when he said words to the effect of, "I hate for people to do dumb nigger shit," in violation of Rules 2, 8 and 9, be SUSTAINED.

Officer Dixon stated in his recorded interview that he did not recall the incident and that he did not believe he would have used such language in front of members of the public. Even though Officer Dixon's statement seemed credible, it does not overcome the statement given by Mr.

Mr. statement, given just two weeks after the incident, was consistent with the complaints previously filed by both Mr. and Mr. All three men stated that Officer Dixon used the phrase, "nigger shit", or "nigga shit" while speaking to Mr. and Mr. Weight is given that two separate individuals filed similar complaints against Officer Dixon, and their complaints were corroborated by Mr. a witness identified by IPRA following the initial complaints.

The use of racially tainted language by a police officer, such as the phrases, "nigger shit" or "nigga shit," is reasonably described as not only disrespectful and unjustified, but brings discredit upon the Chicago Police Department.

Based on the evidence, it is more likely than not that Officer Ricardo Dixon made the comment(s): "I hate for people to do dumb nigger shit" or words to that effect, in violation of Chicago Police Department Rules and Regulations.

## VII. RECOMMENDED DISCIPLINE FOR SUSTAINED ALLEGATIONS
