Non-Concurrence with COPA penalty recommendation for:

Police Officer August Hyde #15058

Dear Chief Administrator:

In reviewing the above mentioned Log Investigation:

The Department concurred with COPA's sustained findings for Allegations #1 and #2 and the Department recognized the serious misconduct identified in this investigation. The Department does not concur with the recommended penalty of a forty-five (45) day suspension because the recommendation did not consider Officer Hyde's disciplinary history.

Officer Hyde has been a Chicago Police Officer for fourteen (14) years and has not had a sustained complaint in his entire career. Department Orders require that a suspension recommendation must give appropriate consideration to the member's previous disciplinary history.<sup>1</sup>

The Department concurs that COPA's investigation identified serious misconduct warranting discipline and believes that taking into account Officer Hyde's lack of any prior disciplinary history, a suspension of thirty (30) days is a more appropriate penalty. The Department will also ensure that Officer Hyde receives additional training through the Department's Procedural Justice Program.
