Based on the discussion during the meet and confer and the Department's concerns, COPA agrees to change the disputed finding (Allegation No. 1 against Officer Sykes) to "unfounded." Although the actions of Officer Sykes may have been permissible, COPA recommends that Officer Sykes receive additional deescalation training.
