NARRATIVE

EVENT #01391. BWC RECORDED EVENT. IN SUMMARY, R/OS RESPONDED TO A CALL OF AN OFFICER ASKING FOR MORE CARS AT A DRAG RACING DISTURBANCE AT 9500 S EWING. THIS DISTURBANCE WAS AN ONGOING EVENT WITH AN UNRULY AND AGGRESSIVE CROWD THAT HAD BEEN GOING ON FOR MORE THAN AN HOUR. THE INITIAL CALL OF DRAG RACERS OCCURRED AT 13000 S TORRENCE. THE DRAG RACING CROWD THEN TRAVELED TO 87/LAKE SHORE DRIVE AND BACK TO 9500 S EWING DISREGARDING OFFICERS COMMANDS TO DISPERSE THE CROWD. R/OS ARRIVED TO THE LOCATION OF 9500 S EWING WHERE OFFICERS HAD BEEN NOTIFIED VIA OEMC THAT THE CROWD WAS FLASHING LIGHT BEAMS IN THE OFFICERS EYES IN ORDER TO OBSTRUCT THEIR VISION. THE CROWD ONCE AGAIN WAS REFUSING TO DISPERSE BLOCKING THE INTERSECTION AND DISREGARDING TRAFFIC LANES LEAVING VEHICLES CROWDED IN EVERY DIRECTION AND DOING DOUGHNUTS IN THE MIDDLE OF THE INTERSECTION. PEOPLE WERE HANGING OUTSIDE OF THEIR VEHICLES AND SCREAMING OBSCENITIES AT OFFICERS. WHEN R/OS ARRIVED ON SCENE, R/OS EXITED THEIR SQUAD CAR AND BEGAN TO APPROACH THE INTERSECTION IN ORDER TO ASSIST THE OTHER OFFICERS IN DIRECTING TRAFFIC AND DISPERSING THE CROWDS OF VEHICLES AND PEOPLE THAT WERE RUNNING IN TRAFFIC. AS R/OS APPROACHED THE INTERSECTION, R/OS OBSERVED A MARKED SQUAD CAR WITH ALL EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT ACTIVATED WITH LIGHTS AND SIRENS (VEHICLE 7826 BEAT 433) OCCUPIED TWICE WITH TWO POLICE OFFICERS IN FULL DUTY UNIFORM. R/OS OBSERVED A MASKED INDIVIDUAL WHO WE NOW KNOW AS [O] NOVORITA, JORDON DISREGARD OFFICERS EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT, CLIMBING ON TO THE BACK OF THE SQUAD CAR VIOLENTLY ATTEMPTING TO CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE SQUAD CAR VEHICLE. R/OS HAD PRIOR KNOWLEDGE THAT THE TWO OFFICERS WERE SEATED INSIDE THEIR MARKED SQUAD CAR. R/OS GAVE VERBAL COMMANDS FOR THE SAFETY OF THE OFFICERS INSIDE THE VEHICLE AND FOR THE OFFENDER ATTEMPTING TO GET ON TOP OF THE SQUAD CAR WITH HIS FEET ON THE BACK BUMPER AND HIS HANDS AND FOREARM ON THE TOP OF THE SQUAD CAR. AFTER DISREGARDING R/OS VERBAL COMMANDS TO GET OFF OF THE VEHICLE, R/OS PULLED THE OFFENDER OFF OF THE MARKED SQUAD CAR BY THE BACK OF HIS SHIRT. IN ORDER TO GAIN CONTROL OF THE OFFENDER, R/OS COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY TAKE DOWN. WHILE ON THE GROUND, [O] NOVORITA, JORDON BEGAN TO STIFFEN HIS BODY REFUSING TO PUT HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK DISREGARDING R/OS MULTIPLE VERBAL COMMANDS TO PUT HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK. OFFENDER BEGAN TO FLAIL HIS LEGS EVADING THE ARREST. WITH THE HELP OF R/OS AND ASSISTING OFFICERS [O] NOVORITA, JORDON THEN COMPLIED AND WAS HANDCUFFED WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT. OFFENDER WAS DETAINED AT 0055 HRS AND WAS PLACED INTO CUSTODY AT 0056HRS AND TRANSPORTED BY BEAT 431 (WAGON) FOR PROCESSING TO 004. [O] NOVORITA, JORDON TAKEN TO SOUTH SHORE HOSPITAL FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED TO THE MOUTH AND NOSE AND WAS SEEN BY DR [REDACTED]. OTHER OFFICERS ON SCENE STATED THE SAME OFFENDER WAS SEEN EARLIER BANGING BOTH OF HIS FISTS ON THE FRONT HOOD OF THE CPD WAGON (NO DAMAGE TO REPORT). ET ORDERED FOR THE HAND PRINTS LEFT ON THE SQUAD CAR BY THE OFFENDER AT 0229HRS. AREA 2 NOTIFIED AT 0227HRS. PRISONER PROPERTY INVENTORIED UNDER #15160083 AND PRISONER JEWELRY INVENTORIED UNDER INVENTORY #15160084. E.T. HEINS #4410 BT 5823 ON SCENE TO PROCESS VEHICLE AND PICTURES OF INJURIES SUSTAINED TO THE OFFENDER AT 1555SHRS.
