II. SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

The complainant, ██████████ alleged that Det. William Donnelly, Officer Michael Mancha, and Officer Kyle Gruba unlawfully arrested ██████████ further alleged that his brother, ██████████ was unlawfully detained, and his vehicle was searched without consent. ██████████ alleged a detective denied him (██████████) essential medical care until he agreed to give a sworn statement regarding a burglary.

In an interview with COPA, ██████████ said he was at the doctor's office when an officer entered a room he was in and told him he was under arrest. ██████████ indicated that the officer would not allow the nurse to draw blood from him, and he was not allowed to speak with the pharmacist to get his medical supplies. ██████████ was handcuffed and taken outside, where he observed his brother, ██████████ handcuffed as the officers searched his vehicle. ██████████ was transported to the police station and was not allowed his requested medical treatment until he provided a statement to Det. Donnelly.

The Department Reports indicated that ██████████ burglarized a home at ██████████ S. Pulaski. Cameras located in the vicinity of ██████████ S. Pulaski captured ██████████ casing the house and eventually walking away from the area. A CTA camera showed ██████████ enter a CTA bus with items in his hand that appear to be from the burglarized home. One of the passengers on the bus, Eric Sempek, identified ██████████ via a photo array. ██████████ was seen on camera exiting the bus on 111th and Wentworth. Det. Donnelly requested a list of the IDOC halfway homes in the vicinity of 111th and Wentworth. Officers were sent to the halfway house on ██████████ ██████████. Upon arrival, ██████████ was identified as a resident, but he was preparing to be discharged from the residence. On July 13, 2020, tactical officers actively searched for ██████████ and located him at a clinic on 111th and State.

The BWC of Officer Mancha shows him approach ██████████ (who was smoking marijuana), ordered him to exit his vehicle, and placed him in handcuffs. ██████████ informed Officer Mancha that ██████████ was inside the medical building. Officer Mancha entered the medical building and asked if ██████████ was there. Officer Mancha called for ██████████ by name and told him that he needed to speak with him when he was finished. (Officer Mancha never told the nurse to stop what she was doing.) The video showed Officer Mancha waiting patiently and treating ██████████ respectfully. Officer Mancha did not tell ██████████ he was under arrest, and he had to leave. Officer Gruba entered the medical building and informed ██████████ that he was under arrest, and placed him in handcuffs. The video showed the nurse speaking with ██████████ and told him that he had to call the pharmacy for his medical supplies. When the officers exited the building, ██████████ was observed in handcuffs, and a sergeant was observed searching ██████████ belongings. The sergeant informed ██████████ that they had a warrant for his arrest.
