Dear Chief Administrator Kersten:

After a careful review of the above referenced complaint log number, the Chicago Police Department (Department) concurs with the findings, but does not concur with the penalties as they pertain to Sergeant Milton Kinnison, Star No. 2561. Pursuant to the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Department provides the following comments.

The COPA investigation recommended a 10-day suspension for Sergeant Milton Kinnison (Sergeant Kinnison), after concluding that he:

1. While detaining [REDACTED] [REDACTED] grabbed her arm, injuring her, without justification.

The Department agrees with COPA's sustained findings. However, the Department believes a 5-day suspension is a more progressive discipline. Sergeant Kinnison has no disciplinary history in the last five years and has received 126 various awards and commendations.

The Department looks forward to discussing this matter with you pursuant to MCC-2-78-130(a)(iii).
