Dear Chief Administrator Kersten:

After a careful review of the above referenced complaint log number, the Chicago Police Department (Department) does not concur with the recommended findings or penalty recommendation, as they pertain to Detective Da Crushshon, Star No. 20365. The Department concurs with the recommended finding and penalty as they pertain to Police Officer Jameel Carter, Star No.10992. Pursuant to the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Department provides the following comments:

The COPA investigation recommended a suspension of 7-day for Detective Da Crushshon (Detective Da) after concluding that he:

1. Handcuffed [REDACTED] without justification.
2. Failed to submit an ISR, relative to the detention of [REDACTED] without justification.
3. Acted in an unprofessional manner.
4. Subjected [REDACTED] to a pat down, without justification.

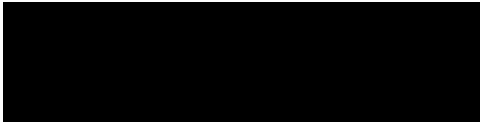
The COPA investigation recommended a Reprimand for Police Officer Jameel Carter (Officer Carter) after concluding that he:

1. Handcuffed [REDACTED] without justification.
2. Failed to submit an ISR, relative to the detention of [REDACTED] without justification.
3. Acted in an unprofessional manner.
4. Subjected [REDACTED] to a pat down, without justification.

As it pertains to Officer Carter, the Department concurs with COPA's findings and penalty. Regarding, Detective Da Crushshon, the Department agrees with COPA's sustained findings but instead recommends a 5-day suspension. Detective Da has received 23 various awards and one SPAR. The Department believes a 5-day suspension is more aligned with progressive discipline.

The Department looks forward to discussing this matter with you pursuant to MCC-2-78-130(a)(iii).
