

SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL SUMMARY REPORT

This **Supplemental Final Summary Report** reflects the agreement reached by COPA and the Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department (“CPD”) following discussions¹ on COPA’s findings and disciplinary recommendations regarding **Sergeant Jerry Duskocz # 1397**.

Following COPA’s issuance of its FSR, COPA provided the final disciplinary file related to COPA’s recommendations to CPD. On January 19, 2024, pursuant to M.C.C. §2-178-130(a), the Superintendent issued a non-concurrence as to certain recommended findings and penalties related to this log number.

Pursuant to M.C.C. §2-78-130(a)(iii), COPA and CPD engaged in discussions regarding the Superintendent’s non-concurrence. Based on a discussion of applicable law, the burden of proof, the facts and available evidence in this case, and in the interests of settlement, COPA has agreed to change the findings for the following allegations:

- Allegation #1 that Sergeant Duskocz placed his hand around the neck of [REDACTED] without justification is Exonerated.
- Allegation #3 that Sergeant Duskocz failed to correct Officer Sanchez when officer Sanchez stated words to the effect of, “His feelings are hurt. He’s saying he wants to kill himself now” is Exonerated.
- Sergeant Duskocz will receive a one-day suspension.
