

SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL SUMMARY REPORT

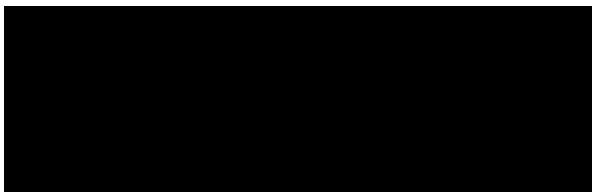
This **Supplemental Final Summary Report** reflects the agreement reached by COPA and the Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department (“CPD”) following discussions¹ on COPA’s findings and disciplinary recommendations regarding **Officer Roger Farias, star #9942, Sgt. Khristopher Rigan, star #1279, and Lt. Thomas Keane, star #323.**

Following COPA’s issuance of its FSR, COPA provided the final disciplinary file related to COPA’s recommendations to CPD. On April 17, 2024, pursuant to M.C.C. §2-178-130(a), the Superintendent issued a non-concurrence as to certain recommended findings and penalties related to this log number.

Pursuant to M.C.C. §2-78-130(a)(iii), COPA and CPD engaged in discussions regarding the Superintendent’s non-concurrence. COPA maintains the initial findings are appropriate. Based on a discussion of applicable law, the burden of proof, the facts and available evidence in this case, and in the interests of settlement, the parties agreed as follows:

- Allegation #1 that Officer Roger Farias falsely accused ██████████ of battering him inside the Bounce Nightclub is Not Sustained;
- Allegation #2 that Officer Roger Farias knowingly and intentionally signed a false complaint identifying ██████████ as his assailant during the altercation inside the Bounce Nightclub is Not Sustained;
- Allegation #3 that Officer Roger Farias abused his authority as a police officer to have ██████████ falsely arrested is Not Sustained;
- Allegation #9 that Officer Roger Farias willfully made a false or misleading statement resulting in the arrest of ██████████ is Not Sustained;
- Allegation #3 that Sgt. Kristopher Rigan falsely arrested ██████████ without justification is Exonerated;
- Allegation #1 that Lt. Thomas Keane falsely arrested ██████████ is Exonerated;
- COPA agrees on a Reprimand for Sgt. Rigan and Lt. Keane.
