

SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL SUMMARY REPORT

This Supplemental Final Summary Report reflects the agreement reached by COPA and the Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department (“CPD”) following discussions¹ on COPA’s findings and disciplinary recommendations regarding Officer Bogdan Kalynyuk, Star #7932; Officer Jacob German, Star # 15650; Officer Lysander Gonzalez, Star #6642; and Officer Luis Otero II, Star #3276.

Following COPA’s issuance of its FSR, COPA provided the final disciplinary file related to COPA’s recommendations to CPD. On January 30, 2025, pursuant to M.C.C. §2-178-130(a), the Superintendent issued a non-concurrence as to certain recommended findings and penalties related to this log number.

Pursuant to M.C.C. §2-78-130(a)(iii), COPA and CPD engaged in discussions regarding the Superintendent’s non-concurrence. Based on a discussion of applicable law, the burden of proof, the facts and available evidence in this case, and in the interests of settlement, the parties agreed as follows:

- Allegation #2 that Officer Kalynyuk improperly arrested [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Allegation #3 that Officer Kalynyuk improperly seized the firearm of [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Allegation #4 that Officer Kalynyuk failed to accurately complete the Arrest Report, Case Report, and Investigatory Stop Report for [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Allegation #1 that Officer German and Officer Gonzalez improperly arrested [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Allegation #2 that Officer German and Officer Gonzalez improperly seized the firearm of [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Allegation #3 that Officer German and Officer Gonzalez failed to accurately complete the Arrest Report, Case Report, and Investigatory Stop Report for [REDACTED] is Exonerated.
- Officer Otero will receive a written reprimand and additional re-training regarding vehicle searches for Allegation #1 that Officer Otero improperly searched a vehicle bearing the plate [REDACTED] without justification.
