**COPA RELEASES VIDEO & OTHER MATERIALS FROM FATAL OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING
NEAR 4300 W. NORTH AVE**

Today, the Civilian Office of Police Accountability (COPA) is releasing video and other materials related to a fatal officer-involved shooting that occurred near 4300 W. North Avenue. COPA investigators immediately responded to the scene and began the investigation.

On May 29, 2025, the Chicago Police Department (CPD) notified COPA of an officer-involved shooting. Preliminary information indicates this incident began when CPD officers were on patrol when they attempted to conduct an investigatory stop of an individual. As officers approached, the individual fled on foot as the officers pursued. While attempting to detain the individual, the officers gave verbal commands, and a struggle ensued. A round was discharged, striking an officer in the leg. A separate officer discharged their weapon, striking the individual. The officer was transported to the hospital in serious condition. The individual was transported to the hospital and was pronounced deceased. A gun was recovered on scene.

COPA serves as the designated agency for the City of Chicago authorized to release video and other materials per the Consent Decree and the City's Video Release Policy.
