Dear Interim Chief Administrator White:

After a careful review of the above referenced complaint log number investigation, the Chicago Police Department (Department) concurs with the recommended sustained findings and with the penalty recommendations as they pertain to Officer Fidel Legoretta #5902 and Officer Eduardo Hernandez # 18648.

The COPA investigation recommended a penalty of a 1 to 29-day suspension for Officer Legoretta after concluding that he:

1. Searched a vehicle without justification.

The COPA investigation also recommended a penalty of a Reprimand for Officer Hernandez after concluding that he:

1. Detained the motorist without justification while the trunk of his vehicle was unlawfully searched;
2. Failed to timely activate his BWC and record the entire incident.

Regarding Officer Legoretta, the Department concurs with the recommended finding and will implement, consistent with the penalty recommendation, a five (5) day suspension. Regarding Officer Hernandez, the Department concurs with the recommended findings and will implement the Reprimand.
